NEW VETERAN LICENSE PLATES

PennDOT is proud to announce the issuance of five new veteran license plates. The Department worked closely with all five branches of the military to develop the design of these plates.

The new plates provide an opportunity for veterans of the various military branches to proudly display support for their branch of service. The five new veteran license plates are:



U.S. Coast Guard Veteran



U.S. Air Force Veteran



U.S. Navy Veteran



U.S. Army Veteran



U.S. Marine Corps Veteran

These new plates portray the standard registration plate colors of blue, white and yellow, and the service-approved emblem. An applicant may apply by completing Form MV-150, "Application for U.S. Military Veteran Registration Plate" and attaching a certified copy of Form DD214, "Separation Papers or Discharge Papers," which indicates honorable discharge service. Form MV-150 is available on PennDOT's Driver and Vehicle Services Web site, www.dmv.state.pa.us. The fee for these type of plates is \$20, in addition to any annual registration fees that may be due.
