REMINDER TO ONLINE PROCESSORS AND DEALERSHIPS

As a reminder, when processing dealer title applications, an authorized representative of the dealership must present an acceptable proof of identification credential AND their dealer registration card or summary card along with the application and proof of ownership. Online processors are reminded that copies of the acceptable proof of identification credential and either the dealer registration card or summary card must be included with the work submitted to PennDOT.

In addition, dealerships are reminded when submitting work through PennDOT's counter services, authorized persons are only permitted to have work processed for one dealership, not multiple dealerships and they are only permitted one piece of retail work per day.

NEWLY DESIGNED ANTIQUE REGISTRATION PLATES

PennDOT is proud to announce the issuance of the newly designed Antique registration plate and Antique Motorcycle registration plate.

The Antique registration plate continues to reflect the "Family of Plates" color scheme of blue, white and yellow. Pennsylvania is printed at the top of the plate and the words "Antique Vehicle" are printed at the bottom of the plate. The words, "PA ANTIQUE HISTORIC VEHICLE" have replaced the image of the red antique vehicle on the left side of the plate.

The Antique Motorcycle registration plate was updated to reflect the "Family of Plates" color scheme of blue, white and yellow. "Pennsylvania" is printed at the top of the plate. "Antique MC" is printed at the bottom of the plate.

Vehicle owners who have the old-style antique registration plates and wish to obtain the newly designed plates may request a replacement plate featuring the updated design by completing Form MV-44, "Application for Duplicate Registration Card, Replacement of Registration Plate, Renewal Sticker or Weight Class Sticker of Transfer of Registration." In Section B, the reason block "Other" must be checked and the explanation must indicate "New-style antique plate requested." The replacement fee of \$7.50 is required. Please note, owners are not required to replace their old-style plate with the new design.

- ❖ MV-150W, "Application for World War II Era U.S. Military Veteran Registration Plate." Edition date is 4-13.

The following are revised forms:

- ❖ MV-1L, "Application for Lessee Information," now has an edition date of 4-13.
- ❖ MV-70S, "Bureau of Motor Vehicle Schedule of Fees," now has an edition date of 2-13.
- ❖ MV-77, "Application for Farm Vehicle Registration Plate or for Farm Vehicle 2 Year Certificate of Exemption," now has an edition date of 2-13.
- ❖ MV-145A, "Person with Disability Parking Placard Application," now has an edition date of 3-13.
- ❖ MV-150, "Application for U.S. Military Veteran Registration Plates," now has an edition date of 4-13.
- ❖ MV-911, "Application for Special Fund License Plate," now has an edition date of 4-13.
