Act 36 – Share the Road Registration Plate

Act 36, signed into law on June 8, 2016, provides for the issuance of a new “Share the Road” special fund registration plate effective August 8, 2016.

Act 36, referred to as the David (Dave) Bachman Act, was enacted in memory of a PennDOT employee who served as the Department’s first Bicycle/Pedestrian Coordinator. All proceeds from the sale of this registration plate fund the Department’s Bicycle & Pedestrian safety efforts, as well as highway infrastructure signage for bicyclists with the purpose of wayfinding and/or safety.

This plate uses the standard registration plate colors of blue, white and yellow and a graphic image of the Shared Lane Marking including two Chevrons, a bicycle silhouette and the words “Allow 4 Feet to Pass.” The bottom of the plate reads “Share the Road.”

Applicants may apply by completing Form MV-917, “Application for Share the Road Registration Plate.” The cost of the plate is \$40. This plate may also be personalized for a fee of \$100 in addition to the \$40 plate cost.
