New Military Registration Plates

PennDOT is proud to announce the issuance of five new military license plates for members of the U.S. Armed Forces. The Department worked closely with the military to develop the design of these plates.

These plates will portray the standard registration colors of blue, white and yellow and a graphic image of the specific service-approved image.

These plates may only be used on passenger vehicles and trucks with a registered gross weight of not more than 14,000 pounds. The new registration plates are as follows:

U.S. Air Force – The tag type code to issue this license plate is KE. The fee is \$20.

U.S. Army – The tag type code to issue this license plate is KC. The fee is \$20.

U.S. Coast Guard – The tag type code to issue this license plate is KG. The fee is \$20.

U.S. Navy – The tag type code to issue this license plate is KD. The fee is \$20.

U.S. Marine Corps – The tag type code to issue this license plate is KF. The fee is \$20.

Applicants may apply by completing Form MV-150AD, “Application for Members of U.S. Military Registration Plate.” This form requires the service member to self-certify their status as a member of the U.S. Armed Forces. This form will be available on our website at www.dmv.pa.gov on February 1, 2017.
