- All work activities on the HOV Lane must be approved in advance by Mr. Ed Brennan, Tunnel Manager
- All work activities should be restricted to the following days and times:
10:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Mon. thru Thurs. When the HOV is totally closed
9:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m., Mon. thru Thurs. When the HOV is totally closed
7:00 p.m. Fri. to 4:00 a.m. Mon. When HOV is open Outbound (Northbound)
Work activities will be considered for other times on a case by case basis.
- Access to and from the HOV and travel on the HOV must always follow the proper direction that the HOV is operating in (**such as never traveling southbound on the weekend**) and use the actual access point in the proper mode and direction (**such as never traveling around a closed gate or over traffic islands**).
- When the HOV is closed all entries and exits must be made from a gate or gates controlled by and HOV operator.
- All work done when the HOV is open must follow Publication 203
- Call Ed Brennan in advance (391-1775) to discuss with him your work plans and the need to have any gates opened or closed to accommodate access to your work site and to be made aware of any special events which could impact the HOV schedule.
- This form must be submitted to Mr. Brennan at least 3 working days (a Fax @ 381-1839 is permitted) before your activity (unless it's an emergency situation).
- This approved form must be in your possession (a Fax copy is acceptable) when you work on the HOV.
