### Act 89 – Fee Adjustments

Act 89, which became law on November 25, 2013, amends many sections of Title 75 effective July 1, 2014. Act 89 represents an investment in Pennsylvania's future: increasing public safety, driving commerce, creating jobs and providing reliable funding for our transportation needs without leaving the bill to our future generations.

The Act amended the following sections of Title 75:

- Section 1353 adjusts the fee for the Preserve Our Heritage special fund registration plate from \$35 to \$54.
- Section 1355 adjusts the fee for the PA Zoological special fund registration plate from \$35 to \$54.
- Section 1927 adjusts the fee for a registration plate transfer from \$6 to \$9
- Section 1928 adjusts the fee agents pay for the purchase of a temporary registration plate from \$5 to \$14 and also adjusts the fee agents may charge for their issuance of a temporary registration plate not to exceed a total of \$10 to \$14. (See NOTE below.)
- Section 1929 adjusts the fee for a replacement registration plate from \$7.50 to \$11.
- Section 1930 adjusts the fee for the issuance of a legislative registration plate from \$20 to \$76.
- Section 1931 adjusts the fee for a personalized registration plate from \$20 to \$76.
- Section 1931.1 adjusts the fee for a Street Rod registration plate from \$20 to \$51.
- Section 1958 adjusts the fee for an annual certificate of inspection from \$2 to \$5 and semi-annual certificate of inspection from \$1 to \$3.

Updated motor vehicle forms and publications reflecting the above fee changes will be available on the PennDOT website on July 1, 2014. Beginning July 1, 2014, the updated forms must be used.

As a reminder, please refer to the April 2014 edition of the Driver and Vehicle Services Update, bulletin 14-5, for previously announced ACT 89 fee adjustments also effective July 1, 2014.

NOTE: Section 1928, Temporary and Electronically Issued Registration Plates. The agent may charge up to a total maximum of \$28 to the customer, \$14 of which is allowed to cover the fee the agent paid for the temporary registration plate, and an additional charge of up to \$14 of which is a permissible charge for the agent's services. As always, fees charged by agents, for the issuance of temporary registration plates, are established by each agent business provided they are within the fees set by the Vehicle Code.
