SURFACE TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE ACT OF 1982 HEAVY VEHICLE USE TAX

As mandated by the Federal Government's Surface Transportation Assistance Act of 1982, effective October 1, 1985, all states must verify that the Federal Heavy Vehicle Use Tax has been paid.

What does this mean to me?

Prior to renewing a vehicle registration or registering a vehicle which has been purchased more than 60 days before registration, you must submit a copy of your IRS Form 2290, validated by the IRS.

What if I don't have a validated IRS Form 2290?

Submit a photocopy of your IRS Form 2290 and a photocopy of both sides of your cancelled check made payable to the IRS.

What vehicles are affected?

All vehicles with a registered gross weight or combination weight of 55,000 lbs. and over and all buses (excluding school buses) with a minimum seating capacity of 73 seats.

What if I am in the logging and/or agricultural business?

In this case submit your IRS Form 2290 and also declare the use of the vehicle on the reverse side of this form. Return your proof that Heavy Vehicle Use Tax has been paid along with your vehicle registration application in the envelope provided.
