PROOF OF INSURANCE

FOR CLARIFICATION: with the passage of the new insurance law **Act 132 of 2013, Senate Bill 1040, effective February 21, 2014**, all agents of the Department (this includes all stations/inspectors) must accept proof of insurance in an electronic format on an electronic device. For inspection purposes, no hard copy proof of insurance is necessary and stations should accept the information electronically. The liability rests with the insured, if when recording the insurance information, damage occurs while the station or inspector is in possession of the device:

“the owner of the electronic device assumes liability for any damage to the electronic device containing the financial responsibility identification card while in possession of the police officer or agents of the department.”
