**UPDATE: Price Adjustment for Certificates of Inspection**

**PRICE ADJUSTMENT FOR CERTIFICATES OF INSPECTION**

Fee adjustments associated with the November 25 signing of House Bill 1060 into law (Act 89) represent an investment in Pennsylvania's future, increasing public safety, driving commerce, creating jobs and providing reliable funding for our transportation needs without leaving the bill to our future generations. On July 1, 2014, the purchase price for the annual safety inspection stickers will be adjusted from \$2.00 to \$5.00 and the purchase price for the semi-annual stickers will be adjusted from \$1.00 to \$3.00.

Official Inspection Stations may charge \$2.00 plus the purchase price of the sticker in effect at the time of replacement for windshield replacement stickers.

There is no charge for Emission Stickers.

Fee schedule signs should be prepared for posting and use effective July 1, 2014.

The MV-436A Inspection Sticker and Insert Order Form has been updated to reflect the fee adjustments and will be available on the Department's website July 1, 2014.
