Product Expiration Dates for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

As you are aware, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) has implemented operational changes in response to Governor Wolf's mitigation guidance regarding COVID-19.

Effective August 31, 2020, expiration dates for commercial driver licenses and commercial learner's permits are extended for Pennsylvania residents through September 30, 2020. Expiration extension deadlines on non-commercial driver license, photo identification cards, learner's permits and camera cards expired on August 31.

Effective August 31, the following products' expiration dates are extended to September 30, 2020:

- Commercial learner's permits scheduled to expire from March 16, 2020, through September 30, 2020;
- Commercial driver licenses scheduled to expire from March 16, 2020, through September 30, 2020; and
- Hazardous Materials Endorsements (HME) for individuals who are a Pennsylvania-licensed commercial driver's license holder and who held a valid, unexpired HME with a determination of no security threat on or after March 6, 2020.

As a reminder, no vehicle registrations, safety inspections and emissions inspections or Persons with Disabilities Parking Placards were extended past June 30, 2020.
