## **Act 108**

Act 108, signed into law on October 24, 2018, has amended multiple sections of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code. The following change is effective on February 21, 2019:

- Purple Heart Registration Plate. Section 1346 of the Vehicle Code was amended to include
  the issuance of a Purple Heart Motorcycle registration plate. Applicants for this registration plate
  must submit Form MV-150, "Application for U.S. Military Service Registration Plate" and a
  legible photocopy of Form DD214, "Separation Papers or Discharge Papers," or one of the
  following, which clearly indicates that a Purple Heart was awarded:
  - A copy of the general order.
  - A copy of the Certificate of Award.
  - o A certification of the award from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs.

Purple Heart registration plates require a fee of \$11.

• Legion of Merit Registration Plate. Section 1368.1 added a special plate for recipients of the Legion of Merit. Applicants for this registration plate must submit Form MV-150, "Application for U.S. Military Service Registration Plate" and a legible photocopy of Form DD214, "Separation Papers or Discharge Papers," indicating the requested designation was awarded. This registration plate will be available for passenger cars or trucks with a registered gross weight of not more than 14,000 pounds. Legion of Merit registration plates require a fee of \$20.
