Product Expiration Dates For Delaware County

The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation announced today in response of the shutdown of Delaware County, the expiration dates for driver licenses, identification cards, vehicle registrations and safety and emission inspections will be extended for Delaware County residents.

For residents who reside in Delaware County and have an expiration date for driver licenses and identification cards scheduled to expire from March 14, 2020, through March 31, 2020, the expiration date is now extended until April 30, 2020.

Additionally, for Delaware County residents with an expiration date for vehicle registrations and safety and emissions inspections scheduled to expire from March 14, 2020, through March 31, 2020, the expiration dates are now extended until April 30, 2020.
