Product Expiration Dates for Bucks and Chester County

The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) is implementing the following operational changes in response to Governor Wolf's mitigation guidance regarding COVID-19. Expiration dates for driver licenses, identification cards, vehicle registrations, and safety and emission inspections will be extended for residents of Bucks and Chester counties:

Driver licenses and photo ID cards for Bucks and Chester County residents that have an expiration date for driver licenses and identification cards scheduled to expire from March 15 through March 31, 2020, the expiration date is now extended until April 30, 2020.

Vehicle registrations, safety inspections and emissions inspections for residents of Bucks and Chester counties scheduled to expire from March 15 through March 31, 2020, the expiration date is now extended until April 30, 2020.

These extensions are in addition to those announced in Montgomery and Delaware counties.
